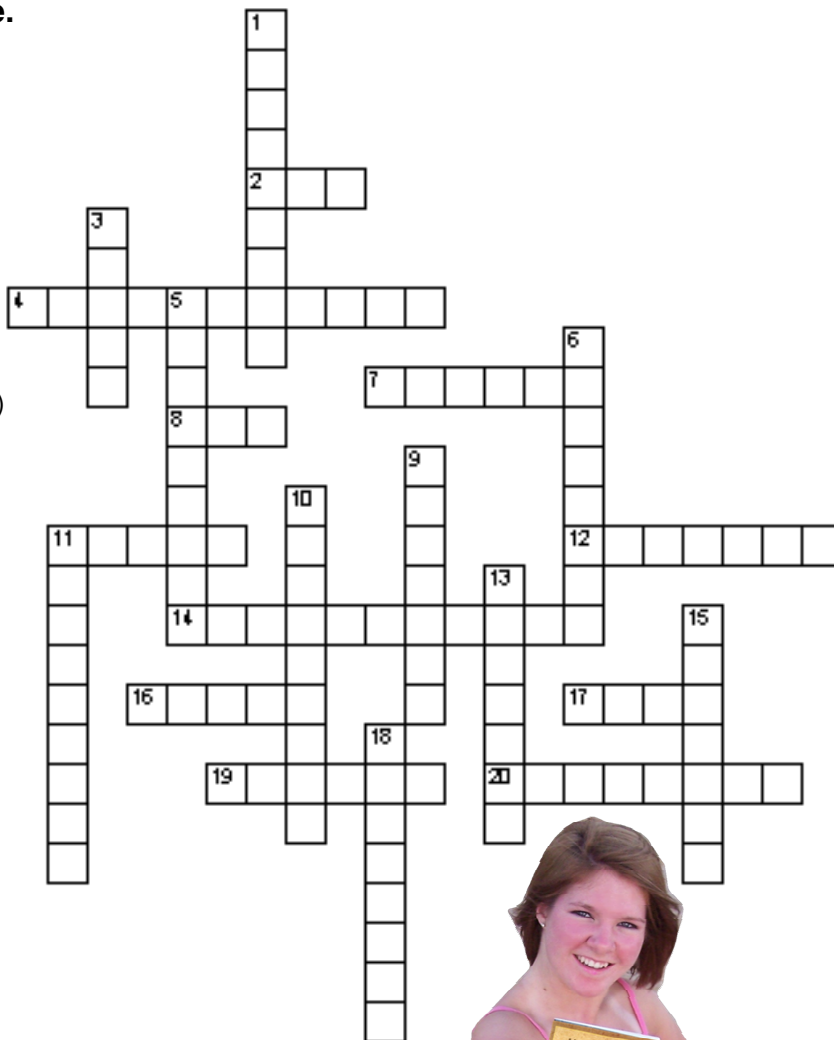


Pocket Sponsor Puzzles





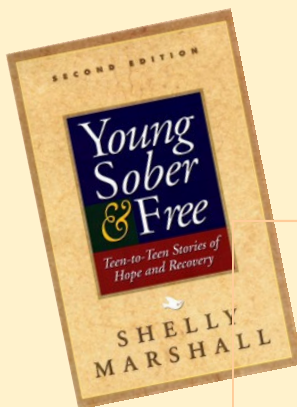
